



Sunday, May 25, Worship in the Community Garden at St. Paul's. "Rogation" comes from the Latin word "rogare," or "to ask." Our Sunday morning Eucharist will be celebrated outside in our community garden, so bring a lawn chair!

Tuesday, May 27-Wednesday, May 28

The days leading up to Ascension Day are called the Rogation Days. On these days we ask ("to ask" is the meaning of the word "rogation" from its Latin origin) God's blessing on our farms and gardens, that we might have an abundance of the fruits of the earth and have goodness to share with those in need.
