We have a full day planned on Sunday, October 26th, as the members and friends of St. Paul's and Grace Lutheran Churches celebrate Reformation Sunday together!



Capital Committee

Previously your church council commissioned a study on the building condition and needs for the next 5 years. Please remember the church was initially constructed in 1908 and major renovation over 17 years ago in 2008. The study was conducted by 4 parishioners who had extensive knowledge and experience in construction trades. A very comprehensive report was generated in May of this year by Mike Hiner and a capital committee was formed and charged with implementation of the report. A copy of the report is on the bulletin board for information and review. There are 3 items that are beyond the scope of annual budgeting and must be treated as capital

There are 3 items that are beyond the scope of annual budgeting and must be treated as capital projects. They consist of crawlspace encapsulation, replacement of Plexiglas with aluminum framed glass for stained glass windows protection, and replacement of 1 HVAC unit with associated air handler and duct. Cost estimates for all projects by outside contractors total over \$100,000 dollars.

We are blessed with some recent contributions earmarked for the capital account which at this time totals \$25,000 dollars. In order to anticipate the timing of the projects the capital committee is asking for a designation of intent by parishioners who would be able to support this activity. This would take the form of a simple note to the tellers of intent to contribute funds designated exclusively for the capital account for remainer of 2025, FY 2026, and FY 2027.



We would like to move forward with crawlspace encapsulation in 2025. This was noted in the study as a priority. It should be noted that we expect to fund these capital projects over time without outside borrowing. St. Paul's Cordova has a very sound balance sheet and from previous experience have demonstrated the ability to fund capital needs.
